At the end of this page is information about using public transport to get to the accommodation from the airport.

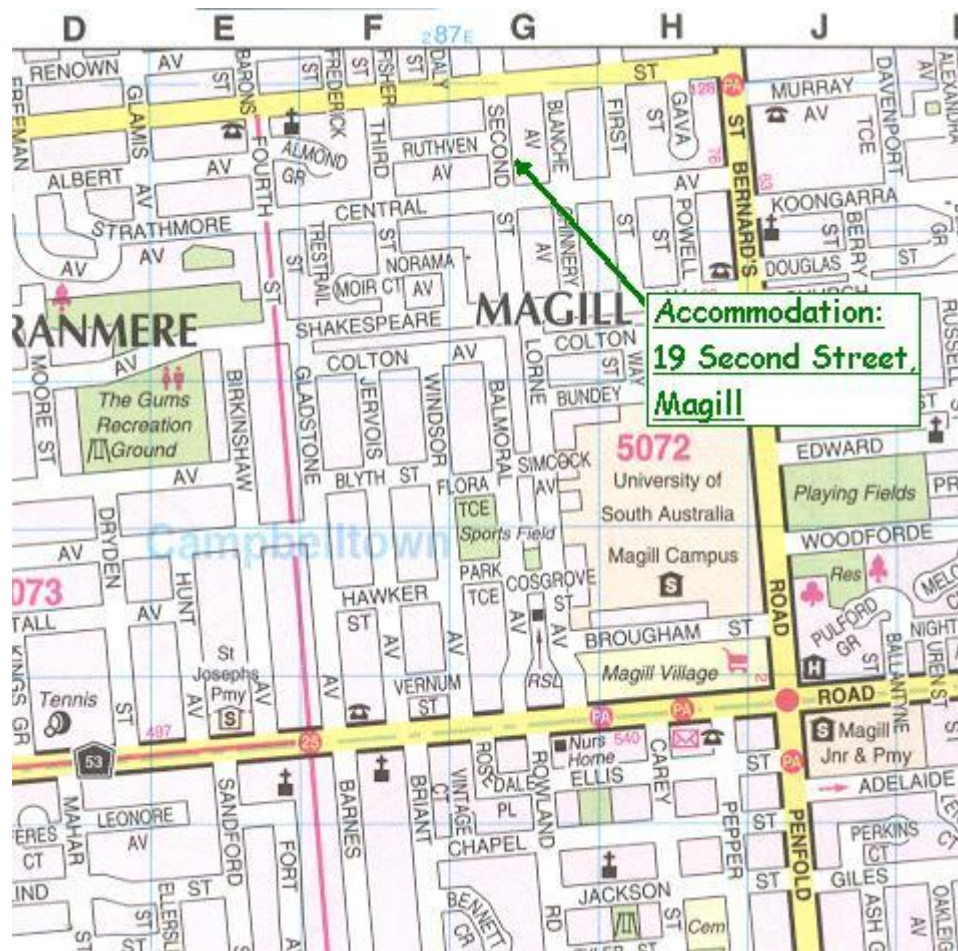
As Neil is an accredited driver, airport pick up and drop off is available upon request. The charge is \$70 for pickup and \$55 for drop off.

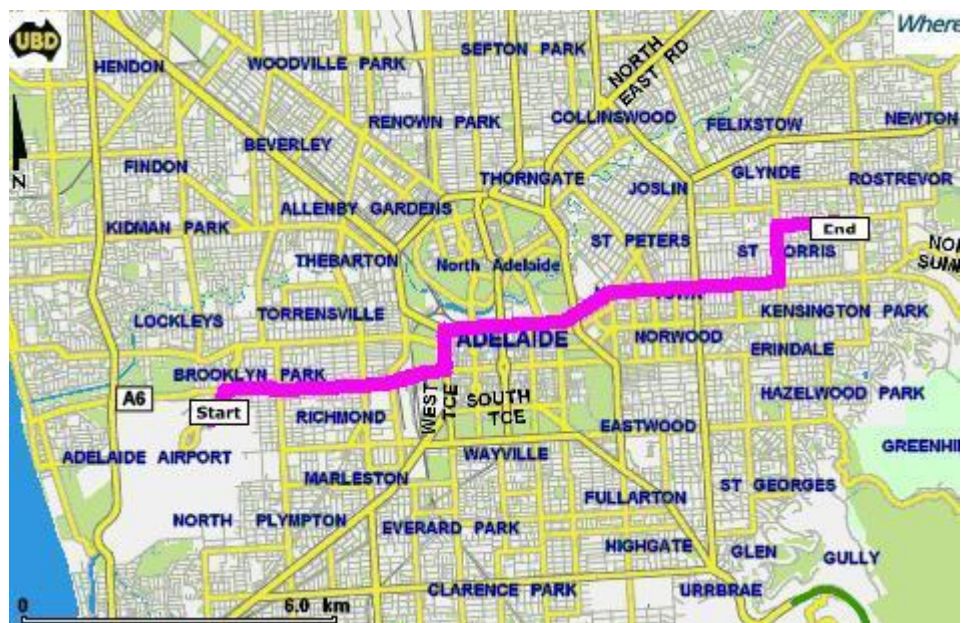

Here is what you have to do if you are taking the bus (public transport) from the airport to our house.

1. See: adelaidemetro.com.au
2. Take the jet bus at the airport and get off at stop E3 on Currie Street in the city.
3. At this point it may be worth dropping into a shop where you can get cheaper bus tickets.

4. Then at the same stop, E3, take H30 or B10 buses.
5. If you take H30 bus, get off at stop 19 or stop 20 on Arthur Street, Magill.
- 6a. Cross Arthur Street and walk to 19 Second Street (less than 200m) and ring door bell on the gate.
- 6b. Note, the B10 bus also takes you to Magill, but the final walk is a little longer, probably about 700m. Get off at stop 18, 20 or 21. The good thing about the B10 bus is that there should be a bus every 15 minutes.

Other useful information:

1. If you are thinking of hiring a car you may want to think about this company: <http://www.cutprice.com.au/>. They are located between the Airport and the City and are quite cheap (about \$25 a day), but note these cheap cars are not new. I suggested these cars are ok for the city, but if you are going to the Barossa or other further out areas, you may want to hire a newer car which can be hired from this same company. Quite a few people who have stayed in our accommodation have hired from this company without any issues, and I think they also have free pickup from the airport.
2. If you are flying in, and are buying travel insurance for your flights and luggage, you may want to check to see if you can increase this insurance cover for the hire car too. I think the extra you pay will be less than if you pay insurance for the car separately, plus you will be covered for other things too.
3. If you are driving, Second Street is off Arthur Street. The speed limit on Arthur Street is 50km per hour and often the police have radar traps on it.
4. www.whereis.com.au - Users can search for a map showing almost any metropolitan address Australia wide. It also gives you directions from one destination to another.

6. [Free Bike hire in Adelaide City](#). Adelaide City Bikes are free to hire between 9am - 4.30pm from Bicycle SA or at other outlets. Hire includes the use of a helmet and if required a bicycle lock. A current passport or drivers license must be deposited by each user at the time of hire. If you wish to hire the bicycles overnight please contact Bicycle SA on 08 8168 9999 to arrange a quote.
